ACREAGE CONTRACT DUE DATE: FEBRUARY 15 (5 DAYS!)

GROWERS: The United Board needs your acreage contracts in order to more efficiently project how many acres will need to be purchased through the bid buy down process. Please mail them to the office at P.O. Box 269, Monte Vista, CO 81144 or call Dwight at 852.2144.

Note: United of Colorado is allowing a 2% discount on all fees and assessments if payment is made by February 15! All payments are due March 15.

2006 Fees and Acreage Assessments

-  If you plan to reduce your 2004 base acreage by 10% in 2006, you will only owe \$12 per acre for administration costs. United's goal is to reduce production.
-  If you plan to plant your 2004 base acreage, you will owe \$50 per acre, as recommended by the future crop committee and voted upon by the membership and \$12 per acre administration fees.
-  If you plant over your 2004 base, you will owe \$50 per acre on the 2004 base and \$100 per acre over the 2004 base. The \$12 per acre administration fee also applies.

ASSESSMENTS ARE CALCULATED ON YOU 2004 BASE (\$50/ACRE)
