As the 2006 planting season winds down, many growers will finish shipping their 2005 crop. Be informed of the possibility of where the market is moving as you choose your avenue of marketing. Remember, UNITED's efforts for orderly marketing provides you, the grower, with consistent steady price returns.

The bulk price target remains consistent and steady at \$9.25 net to grower. Bulk movement continues to be approximately 1/3 of the shipments from the Valley. Grower interest and participation is needed to resume the bulk conference call.
